SUBJECT: DISABLED PERSON VALIDATION STICKERS,
IDENTIFICATION CARDS, AND SPECIAL PLATE
INSIGNIAS (1" X 1")

TO: ALL COUNTY TAX ASSESSOR-COLLECTORS

Ladies and Gentlemen:

The purpose of this Circular is to provide you with information concerning Disabled Person registration insignias, supplemental to that provided in Motor Vehicle Information Circular No. 39-91.

Effective immediately, when issuing a Disabled Person Validation Sticker for any reason, the \$1.00 Disabled Person registration fee is not to be collected.

The Disabled Person Insignia (1" x 1") for display on special plates is obsolete. Persons wishing to obtain this type of insignia should be instructed to complete the Application for Disabled Person Identification Card, Form D12-214. Certification by a physician or an optometrist is not required if evidence can be provided that certification has been recorded on a previous Application for Disabled Person Special Identifying Registration Insignia, Form D12-316. This may be in the form of a registration receipt or a copy of the Form D12-316.

The completed Form D12-214 and the \$5.00 application fee should then be submitted to the applicant's local county tax office. The Disabled Person Identification Card issued can be subsequently exchanged for the new Disabled Person Windshield

Identification Placard (which is designed to hang from the rearview mirror), which will be available in mid 1992. Applicants for Disabled Person Identification Cards should be instructed that they must exchange the current card for the new placard no later than December 31, 1992, if they wish to continue receiving Disabled Person parking privileges.

Instructions for exchanging Disabled Person Identification Cards for the new Disabled Person Windshield Identification Placards will be forthcoming.
