SUBJECT: Student Congress Resolution 72-61  
Additional Aid for Handicapped Students

This will acknowledge the receipt of the above resolution concerning improved facilities for handicapped students. For sometime we have been in the process of improving facilities such as more restroom and ramp facilities, the lowering of drinking fountains and telephones, easier access into buildings, and additional parking facilities. These projects are all in various stages of development at this time. The establishment of a special electronic system for the assistance of blind students on campus is currently under investigation. Such a project will, however, require considerable additional funds and it will be sometime before it can be given final consideration.

Buildings which are now being built do meet all the standards of construction for handicapped students. Davis Hall, which is the administration building, is the first building which has been constructed since the new law regarding facilities for handicapped persons went into effect. We certainly will continue in our efforts to improve the University environment for handicapped students.
