Anniversary theme adds nostalgia to Homecoming '92

A full week of activities culminating with the men's basketball game against Northeast Louisiana is scheduled for UTA's Homecoming '92 celebration Feb. 24-29.

The theme, "An Anniversary Homecoming: The Tradition Continues," encompasses several components of the University that are celebrating milestones in 1992. For example, 1992

marks the 25th year since Arlington State College was renamed The University of Texas at Arlington.

Other anniversaries include the 90th year of the Corps of Cadets, the 25th year of the School of Social Work and the School of Urban and Public Affairs, and the 20th year of the School of Nursing.

"The theme also represents how

long the tradition of education has existed at UTA and accentuates the fact that we have a long and proud heritage," said Homecoming Chair Pat O'Neill.

In a rematch of last year's Southland Conference championship game, UTA will take on defending SLC champion Northeast Louisiana at 7:30 p.m. Saturday, Feb. 29 at Texas Hall. The Lady Mavs play Northeast Louisiana at 5:15 p.m., preceded by a men's alumni game at 3:30 p.m.

Halftime of the men's game against Northeast Louisiana will feature the coronation of the Homecoming king and queen. A dance will follow the game in the Rio Grande Ballroom.

Basketball action during Homecoming week will continue Thursday, Feb. 27 with men's and women's games against Northwestern State. The defending national champion Wheelchair Movin' Mavs basketball team will take the floor at Texas Hall Tuesday, Feb. 25.

On Monday, Feb. 23, a parade of decorated cars, a pep rally and a chili cook-off will kick off Homecoming '92. Other events include the third annual Faculty/Staff Follies, the annual Blue and White Fashion Show and a reception for former and current Student Congress members.

Also included in Homecoming festivities will be the 50-year reunion of the Class of 1942 (see p. 3) and the Military Science Hall of Honor induction ceremony (see p. 4).
