## Why Should You Care?

There are 45,000,000 people in our nation with severe disabilities. This group includes people of all ages, genders, races, religions and income levels.

Disabilities include spinal-cord injury, stroke, multiple sclerosis, diabetes, cerebral palsy, muscular dystrophy, emphysema and major disabilities related to advanced age.

Handicapped Resource Association (H.R.A.) offers people over 18 years of age with severe disabilities the freedom to control their own lives and the opportunity to achieve their highest living standard possible.

H.R.A. provides attendants who deliver personal assistance services such as:

Dressing
Bathing
Exercise
Routine Hair and Skin Care
Shopping / Meal Preparation
Laundry

Clients of H.R.A. choose and supervise their attendants. H.R.A. trains clients and attendants, monitors quality and manages payroll and benefits. Without this help, most H.R.A. clients would face institutionalization or become a burden to their family and friends.
