Student Congress Resolution 71-25

It is my understanding that plans to close Third Street are in process and that this action will be taken at the earliest possible date. I agree with the members of Student Congress that automotive traffic on Cooper Street presents "a clear and present danger to the pedestrians of the campus". Mr. Price has assured me that this problem is being considered at the present time but no definite plans have been made.

Occupancy of Davis Hall and future expansion of the camous west of Cooper Street will make this problem even more acute. Due to the fact that Cooper is both a state highway and city street, there obviously are many details to be worked out. I recommend that we proceed in the development of plans to deal with this problem with all due speed.
