SUBJECT: Student Congress Resolution 71-44

This resolution concerns itself with the improvement of facilities for handicapped students on the UTA campus and at athletic events. Recognizing the fact that some efforts have been made on this campus to accommodate the handicapped student, I am in agreement with Student Congress when they suggest that there are perhaps other things that need to be done. The last part of this resolution suggests that a committee composed of representatives from the Handicapped Students Association and Student Congress advise specific improvements pertaining to handicapped students. To my knowledge a committee to deal with these specific problems does not exist at the present time. I would suggest that such a committee should also include faculty and staff members.

Your consideration of the problems to which this resolution addresses itself will be appreciated.
