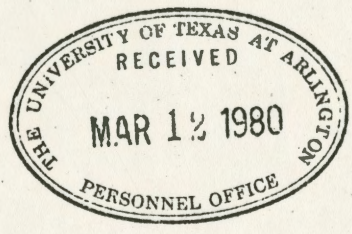

The Select Committee on State Employee Productivity of the Texas House of Representatives will hold a public hearing on Friday, March 21, 1980 in Arlington, Texas.

- When: 9:00 a.m.-Noon, Friday, March 21, 1980
- Where: University of Texas at Arlington - E.H. Hereford University Center, Concho Room, N.W. corner of West and Second Streets
- Who: State Employees, Spokespersons for State Agencies, the Private Sector and other interested persons.
- What: To hear testimony on:

1. Obstacles to job performance such as training needs, personnel policies, work assignments, job conditions and recognition.
2. Personnel policies; training as a function of hiring and promotions; grievance procedures, exit interviews, their findings and the relationship to changes in operation.
3. Implementation and effectiveness of the State Employee Training Act of 1969.
4. Training that is available and areas of needed training.
